IMPORTANT INFORMATION – ONLINE NOTIFICATION OF ABSENCES

Dear Parent/Guardian

As part of our continuous implementation of the COMPASS Education School Management System we are ready to activate the online notification of absences.

From Monday, September 10, 2018, you will be able to enter online notifications explaining your child(ren's) absence via the COMPASS online portal.

If you are entering a notification on the day of your child(ren's) absence:


- Before 10 a.m., you will need to use the *Add Attendance Note* situated next to your child's photo.
- After 10 a.m., you will need to use the *Attendance Note Required* located under My News.

Notifying our school of your child(ren's) absence either prior to, or on the day that they will be away, helps ensure their safety and wellbeing and fulfils your legal responsibility.
