Facilities Update

- As well as general school grounds maintenance, during the recent holidays we had the synthetic turf between our BER and our main school building replaced. The ground beneath the turf was quite unstable, causing an uneven and unsafe surface so this has been excavated and replaced before the new turf was laid.
- The finishing touches to the major renovation and upgrade of our children's toilets were also completed during the school holidays. The last hurdle was the flooring and now that has been completed, all four toilet blocks in the main building are looking brand new and very modern.

School Uniform

- As the weather becomes cooler and our children change from wearing summer uniform to warmer winter uniform items, I would like to remind parents that children are encouraged to put on their jackets/coats before going outside to play on colder days but these are not worn inside the classrooms.
Our classrooms are very well heated, in fact I believe that they often a bit too warm.
Please make sure that your child does not wear any non-uniform items over his/her uniform. If you feel that the weather is especially cold, he/she may wear additional items *beneath* their uniform provided they cannot be seen.
- Yesterday our Grade 6 students received their new 'commemorative' windcheaters and polo shirts with all of their names printed on the back of each garment. The Grade 6 children really look forward to the arrival of these very special uniform items each year and it is important that each one is very clearly labelled inside with the name of the owner. If these garments are lost they cannot be replaced.
