Parent Opinion Survey

Last term more than 200 randomly selected Iramoo families were invited to participate anonymously in the Department of Education & Training annual Parent Opinion Survey. For the first time the survey was completed on-line and we were very pleased indeed to have 114 families respond.

The questions in this year's survey were different to previous years so we have no comparison either to ourselves or to state averages but we have been incredibly impressed with the results and very pleased that our families continue to have such a positive view of our school. As Principal, I was particularly pleased to note that 100% of the parents responded that their child is treated with respect at Iramoo and also that their child enjoys their learning at our school.
